Leineperi Ironworks History

- Was founded in 1771
- Leineperi Ironworks produced and refined iron for various uses
- Iron refining operations ended in 1902
- Area was restored between 1988 and 1994



The Blast Furnace or iron refinery is 18 metres tall. It is one of the three remaining blast furnaces in Finland.
